Operating a residential facility for youth means addressing all needs – food, shelter, supervision, and **clothing.** In emergency shelter situations, many youth come to the Home with only the clothes they are wearing. Supplies of clothes are depleted quickly and at significant expense. It is estimated to cost **\$280/year** for boys and **\$420/year** for girls to provide a sufficient wardrobe of undergarments.
